Updates

Greetings! We are now in the second quarter of the Drug Free Communities Grant year three. To say PCDFC is making progress is an understatement!

The bulk on January was spent in preparation for PCDFC's First Annual Red Ribbon Gala! The Gala was held on February 12, 2016 and was a huge success. The event brought people together for an evening of food, entertainment and guest speakers. Attendee's also shopped at our silent auction complete with hotel stays, fine dining certificates and autographed memorabilia. Thanks to the support of our community, PCDFC raised \$6,000 in proceeds! This money will be used to continue substance abuse and recovery efforts within Pontotoc County.

In March, DFC staff held a small Responsible Beverage Sales and Service (RBSS) training. Also in March, DFC staff along with Ada P.D., conducted alcohol compliance checks. Out of five liquor stores checked only one sold alcohol to a minor. We are committed to the continuation of this very important strategy to insure that alcohol access is reduced.

Finally, discussions have begun with the City of Ada to produce signage for local parks and public areas. This is an environmental strategy aimed at letting the public know that the parks and bike trails are considered a drug free, no tolerance zone. DFC staff hope to have signage created and posted sometime within the third quarter period.
